<p>Write at least 5 multclause sentences. Include a different conjunction in each sentence and make sure it follows our '5 things a sentence needs'.</p> <p>★</p>	<p>Write out your 2, 5, and 10 times tables.</p> <p>★</p>	<p>Draw or paint a weather picture.</p> <p>★</p>	<p>Make a list of the electrical items in your house and for each one say what type of electricity they use, e.g. mains, battery, solar.</p> <p>★</p>
<p>Write an explanation text about something you know a lot about. It could be a toy, a machine, a computer game, etc. Use at least 2 subheadings in your explanation.</p> <p>★★</p>	<p>Write out all your times tables, from the 2 times table to the 12 times table.</p> <p>★★</p>	<p>Keep a weather diary for at least 5 days. Say what the weather is like on each day. Make sure you also find out the temperature on each day.</p> <p>★★</p>	<p>Sticky Knowledge – create a poster to describe at least 5 things you have learnt so far this year. Make sure you explain each piece of sticky knowledge clearly.</p> <p>★★</p>
<p>Write a letter to a famous person or to a book character you like. Set your letter out correctly, tell them about yourself and why you've chosen to write to them. Ask them some questions and remember to end your letter correctly.</p> <p>★★★</p>	<p>Write out the divisions for all your times tables, e.g.</p> <p>$2 \div 2 = 1$</p> <p>$4 \div 2 = 2$</p> <p>$6 \div 2 = 3$</p> <p>★★★</p>	<p>Choose a country and write a non-chronological report or make a poster about what the weather/climate is like in that country. Think about the presentation of your work.</p> <p>★★★</p>	<p>Create a model to link with the work we are doing this half term. It could be something to do with our English work, our Science, Geography or even to do with our class novel, Malamander.</p> <p>★★★</p>

Every child **must** complete at least 1x English, 1x Maths and 1x Geography activity. The children can choose which star level activity they would like to do. Children can do more than one activity from each heading and will be rewarded at the end of the half term, based on how many stars they collect. If children do not complete the minimum number of activities required, they will have to complete the activities during the reward time.
